






### Amali Dimond, 16 NSW

Smalltown singer who dreams of making it big like her stepdad Bernard.


"My mum taught me to sing as she performed in folk clubs, but my stepdad, Bernard, has helped take me to another, more professional level."








Lives on a rose farm and studies physiology.

Noora H, 27


