Inspired by former AFL star **Eddie Betts'** popular book series, *Eddie's Lil' Homies* is an animated children's comedy series that follows eight-year-old Eddie and his two best friends Lottie and Tal as they navigate the complex and often fantastical waters of childhood. Little J, he's five and Big Cuz, she's nine. They're a couple of Indigenous Australian kids living with their Nanna and Old Dog. Little J and Big Cuz are busy with the ups and downs of the playground and classroom. There's always something surprising going on whether it's at school, in the backyard... or beyond. The gaps in Nanna's ramshackle fence led to Saltwater, Desert and Freshwater Country. With the help of Nanna and their teacher Ms Chen, Little J and Big Cuz are finding out all about culture, community and country.

Her Name is Nanny Nellie

TX: January 2024 on NITV and SBS On Demand

Number of Episodes: 1 x 88 mins

In 1925 Australia's Census declared Aboriginal people a 'dying race'. The Australian Museum commissioned three statues of 'full blood' Aboriginal people: a child, a man and a woman, exhibited as nameless objects to be studied. The woman was Nellie Walker, Irene Walker's great grandmother and director Daniel King's great, great grandmother.

Now Irene is on a journey to retrace Nellie's life and understand her times. But first she must find the other statue's descendants, tell them of their ancestors' statues. In this way Irene will honour these ancestors.

This is a timely story by one of Australia's most exciting directors; Ngarigo and Awabakal man Daniel King, documenting his mother's search. This is a profound personal window on a national story, with global consequences for colonial museum collections everywhere.

The series features John Leguizamo, John Ortiz, Irene Bedard, Hani Furstenberg, Steven Boyer, and Isabelle Poloner.

In its second series *Our Law* expands nationwide, following First Nations police on the frontline across New South Wales, Victoria, Western Australia and Queensland. The season also introduces an exciting new dimension to the show, as we ride along with the water police in the Torres Strait Islands. With its unique brand of truth-telling and intimate access to First Nations police officers, recruits and liaisons, this character-driven, observational documentary series rides along on the frontlines of Australia, as First Nations police tackle the justice system from within.

Journey Home - David Gulpilil TX: 2024 on NITV and SBS On Demand Number of Episodes: 1 x 90 mins

David Gulpilil, a Yolnu man of the Mandhalpuyngu clan, was one of Australia's most outstanding Indigenous actors. Since his 1971 debut in Nicholas Roeg's film 'Walkabout' he mesmerised audiences, appearing in over eighteen films. With a career spanning over 50 years, Gulpilil's contribution to the Australian film industry is part of the history of both the Australian cinema and its representation of Indigenous Australians.



This is the story of David Gulpilil's journey home after his passing in 2021, back to his birthplace, the centrepiece of which is his Bäpurru ceremony in Marayuwu near the Arafura Swamp and the remote community of Ramingining, Eastern Arnhem Land in the Northern Territory of Australia.

This is a rare insight into a powerful ceremony of renewal and regeneration and is told completely from the Yolnu perspective, from the perspective of his family. This remarkable event, marking Gulpilil's return to the earth, the completion of his life cycle, draws a direct line between the contemporary world of international fame and 60,000 years of Indigenous culture.

Mothering Sunday

Gentle and timid, Haider (**Ali Junejo**) lives with his wife Mumtaz (**Rasti Farooq**), his father, and his elder brother's family in Lahore, Pakistan. Following a long spell of unemployment, Haider finally lands a job at a Bollywood-style burlesque, telling his family he is a theatre manager, when in actuality, he is a backup dancer. The unusual position shakes up the steadfast traditional dynamics of his household and enables Haider to break out of his shell. As he acclimates to the new job, Haider becomes infatuated with the strong-willed trans woman Biba (**Alina Khan**) who runs the show—an unforeseen partnership that opens his eyes and ultimately his worldview, in ways both unexpected and intimate.

Triangle of Sadness

TX: 2024 on SBS World Movies and SBS On Demand

Things are not always as Instagrammable as they first appear.... In **Ruben Östlund's** wickedly funny Palme d'Or winner, social hierarchy is turned upside down, revealing the tawdry relationship between power and beauty. Celebrity model couple, Carl (**Harris Dickinson**) and Yaya (**Charlbi Dean**), are invited on a luxury cruise for the uberrich, helmed by an unhinged boat captain (**Woody Harrelson**). What first appeared instagrammable ends catastrophically, leaving the survivors stranded on a desert island and fighting for survival.

Corsage

This BAFTA-nominated fictional drama chronicles the later years of Empress Elisabeth of Austria (**Vicky Krieps**). On Christmas Eve 1877, Elisabeth turns 40 and is officially deemed an old woman and starts trying to maintain her public image, once idolised for her beauty. Also starring **Colin Morgan** as George "Bay" Middleton.





The Worst Person in The World

When Adam's (**Mark Duplass**, who is also the director) husband surprises him with weekly Spanish lessons, he's unsure about where or how this new element will fit into his already structured life. However, when tragedy strikes, his Spanish teacher, Cariño (**Natalie Morales**, who also wrote the screenplay), becomes a lifeline he didn't know he needed. Adam develops an unexpected and complicated emotional bond with Cariño—but do you really know someone just because you've experienced a traumatic moment with them? Bittersweet, honest, and at times darkly funny, *Language Lessons* is a disarmingly moving exploration of platonic love.

Emily
