### **Swift Street**

**TX: 2024 on SBS and SBS On Demand**

**Number of Episodes: 8 x 30 mins**

Created and directed by **Tig Terera**, *Swift Street* features an ensemble cast including acclaimed Hollywood star **Cliff Curtis** (*Avatar: The Way of Water*, *Traffic*, *Fast and Furious: Hobbs & Shaw*), **Tanzyn Crawford** (*Tiny Beautiful Things*, *Servant*), **Keiynan Lonsdale** (*My Fake Boyfriend*, *Love, Simon*, *The Divergent Series*), **Eliza Matengu** (*Thor: Love and Thunder*, *Jack Irish*), **Bernie Van Tiel** (*Class of '07*, SBS drama anthology series *Erotic Stories*), and introducing **Alfred 'Alfie' Chuol**.

When 21-year-old Elsie (**Tanzyn Crawford**) - a new-school illicit entrepreneur in her own right - discovers that her old-school hustler father Robert (**Cliff Curtis**) is being hunted down by a merciless crime boss over a bad debt, she decides to help him, sparking the beginnings of a reconciliation and a dubious reign as partners in crime.

## **Four Years**

**TX: 2024 on SBS and SBS On Demand**

**Number of Episodes: 8 x 30 mins**

*Four Years* is a story of a married couple trying to find each other again after being separated for four years. In the spirit of *Normal People*, the series explores love, yearning and miscommunication. Achingly powerful, *Four Years* follows the turbulent marriage of two young Indian lovers, Sridevi and Yash, through three timelines, told through dual perspectives.

Full of romance and the desire to find someone you once loved again, this groundbreaking Australian series uses the Hindi and English languages interchangeably. Created and written by Indian-Australian writer **Mithila Gupta** (*Bump S1&2, The Unlisted, The Heights, Five Bedrooms and Doctor Doctor*).

### The Doll Factory

**TX: Late 2023 on SBS and SBS On Demand**

**Number of Episodes: 6 x 1hr**

Based on the bestselling novel of the same name, this intoxicating story is set in London, 1850. Iris (**Esme Creed-Miles**) paints dolls for a living, alongside her twin sister, Rose (**Mirren Mack**). Iris dreams of becoming an artist. By night, she secretly paints herself. Silas (**Éanna Hardwicke**) is a taxidermist who owns a shop filled with his creations. He dreams of one day finding an item so unique he will be catapulted to fame. Louis (**George Webster**) is a painter and member of the Pre-Raphaelite Brotherhood, searching for his next muse. When Iris meets Silas, and then Louis, she is offered an opportunity to escape and start a new life. To do so, she must abandon her sister, sacrifice her reputation, and launch herself into the unknown. But as Iris' world expands, a story of dark obsession begins to unfold...





## **Babylon Berlin S4**

**In German with English Subtitles**

In an Australian premiere, the fourth season of *Babylon Berlin* sees Inspector Gereon Rath transfer from Cologne to Berlin for a mission, where he unravels dark secrets during his investigation of a highly confidential racket of pornography during the height of the Weimar Republic. ## **The Good Ship Murder**

**TX: 2024 on SBS and SBS On Demand**

Former police detective Jack Grayling, now pursuing his dream of becoming a cabaret singer on a luxury Mediterranean cruise ship, investigates a series of murders on board with the help of ship's First Officer Kate Woods.

## **The Vanishing Triangle**

**TX: 2024 on SBS and SBS On Demand**

**Number of Episodes: 6 x 1hr**

Set in 1990s Dublin, *The Vanishing Triangle* is inspired by true events of the time. Lisa (**India Mullen**; *Normal People, Brassic*) is a young, aspiring, female journalist who witnessed her mother's murder; but the killer was never caught. When Lisa publishes a deeply personal piece in the newspaper about her mother's murder, the killer makes contact and so begins a cat-and-mouse game that will push Lisa to the limit. Together with Detective David (**Allen Leech**; *Downton Abbey, Bohemian Rhapsody, The Imitation Game*) they begin to connect her mother's killing to recent disappearances of young women and suspect an undetected serial killer may be responsible.

## **Everyone Else Burns**

**TX: Late 2023 on SBS On Demand**

**Number of Episodes: 6 x 30 mins**

This biting coming-of-age comedy follows a British family and their conservative Christian sect. Will patriarchal David Lewis (**Simon Bird**; *The Inbetweeners*) ever ascend the church ranks and become an Elder? Will dutiful wife Fiona deviate from her own dogmatic moral compass? Will their naïve 17-year-old daughter Rachel (**Amy James-Kelly**; *Blood, Sex & Royalty*) be allowed to go to university, and will 12-year-old son Aaron ever fend off his secular bullies? *Everyone Else Burns* is a subversive, authentic and biting funny exploration into what it feels like to balance faith, family and identity in a world that could end tomorrow (but probably won't).
