Sophie Monk returns as host of *Love Island Australia* for the sixth time, back at the stunning location: the island of Mallorca in Spain.

Since Sophie burst onto the entertainment scene after being discovered on *Popstars* in 2000, she has never been far from our TV screens and is one of Australia's favourite personalities.

The made-for-TV band Bardot set Sophie on her way, with the No.1 hit, *Poison*, one of the highest selling singles in Australian history in 2000.

After leaving Bardot she moved to Los Angeles and had a successful film career, including cult classics such as *Date Movie* (2006), *Click* (2006) and *Spring Breakdown* (2009).

During the past decade Sophie has become a fixture on Australian television on various shows as well as hosting *Love Island Australia*. She is a regular on *The Hundred with Andy Lee*, and knows exactly what it's like being a star of reality TV.

In 2015 she won Celebrity Apprentice, and in 2017 she attempted to find love on The Bachelorette.

Sophie married Joshua Gross in 2022, and they are together in Mallorca creating their very own island of love as she films another series of *Love Island Australia*.

Have you had relationships before?


My last proper girlfriend was in 2017, so it's been a while.
